## DOTS AND BOXES

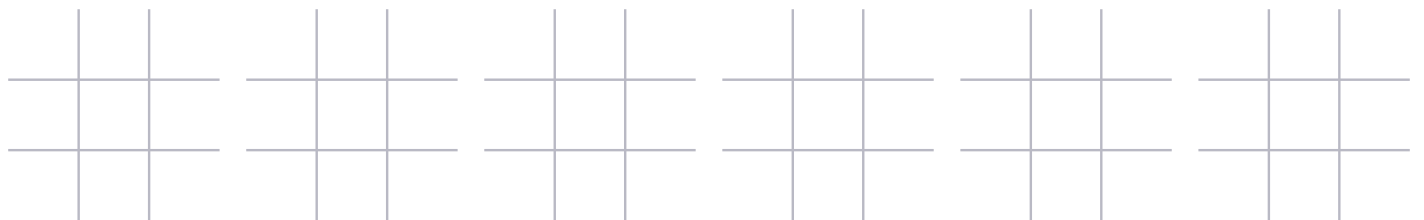


Take turns drawing one line between two dots. Close a box, write your initial in it, go again.
